President Zourabichvili awards those who tragically died in Gudauri rescue operation with medal 'for civil sacrifices'

ccording to the decision, the Presi dent of Georgia Salome Zourabichvili awarded those who died during the rescue operation in Gudauri with a medal "for civil sacrifices".

Zaza Loria, Dimitri Kaadze, Levan Chokheli, Andro Kujoshvili, Giorgi Margiani, Kakha Torchinava, Girgi Venetski, Ketevan Gulaghashvili were awarded for the highest civic responsibility and exemplary, selfless actions during the rescue operation.

When civil servants sacrifice themselves to save someone else's life, the society can freely give them the qualification of heroism," Minister of Defense Juansher Burchuladze said this after arriving at the civil funeral of those who died as a result of the helicopter crash in Gudauri.

He expressed his condolences to the people of Georgia for the tragedy.

"I offer my condolences to the entire Georgian society, this is our tragedy," said Juansher Burchuladze.

On July 29, in Gudauri, during a paragliding flight, 2 persons fell on a rocky slope.

A helicopter belonging to the border police was involved in the rescue operation, which lost control and crashed.

There were 4 crew members on board the helicopter, as well as 2 rescuers from the emergency management service of the Ministry of Internal Affairs and 2 doctors from the emergency coordination and



emergency assistance center of the Ministry of Health.

All eight crew members on board died. As for the paragliders, one survived, and the other, a foreign tourist - died

An investigation has been launched into the incident under Article 275 of the Criminal Code, which implies a violation of air transport operation rules.

Medvedev writes and deletes post saying Georgia should become part of Russia, assistant says account hacked

appeared in the Russian social network one state".

VKontakte, stating that Georgia should become part of Russia and genocide of Russians was organized in Kazakhstan. The post disappeared in a few minutes, although its screenshots were re-uploaded by journalist Ksenia Sobchak.

The post mentions that 'after the liberation of the territories of Kiev and Malorossiya from the nationalists, Russia will be united again'.

"We are on our next campaign to restore the borders of our homeland, which, as we know, does not end anywhere,"

the post said.

Medvedev wrote in the post that 'before 1801, Georgia as a country did not exist and it was created only within the borders of the Russian Empire':

"North and South Ossetia, Abkhazia and the remaining territories of Georgia On August 2, Dmitry Medvedev's post can be united only with Russia as part of



As for Kazakhstan, the post says that "this is an artificial state" and "a former territory of Russia", and the government is evicting various ethnic groups, which can be "considered a genocide of Rus-

It is not known whether this post really belongs to the deputy head of the Security Council. Sobchak suggests that Medvedev's account was hacked. Medvedev himself did not respond to the

"He probably wouldn't touch Northern Kazakhstan, considering his personal meetings with Tokayev. Rhetoric is too much even for him," Sobchak notes.

Later, Dmitry Medvedev's assistant told RIA Novosti that the account had been hacked.

Ombudsman assesses 59 free canteens in 25 municipalities, says overall picture 'unsatisfactory'

he Public Defender's Office checked 59 free canteens in 25 municipalities. According to the Ombudsman's assessment, the current situation in some municipalities both in terms of

food delivery services and sanitary meets the minimum requirements, however, the overall picture is unsatisfactory.

The amount allocated per beneficiary in the free canteens of Tbilisi Municipality amounts to 1,30 GEL, which is less than the

daily amount calculated in the regions. This is mentioned in the monitoring report of free canteens distributed by the Public

According to the information of the Public Defender's office, as a result of the monitoring, it was revealed that: there is no unified standard for the management and delivery of the free canteen service in the country, and the nutritional needs of the beneficiaries are not taken into account when the service is implemented, there were cases when the menu is prepared by an accountant and not by a specialist in the relevant field, in most cases, the menu does not change throughout the year, and also, the majority of institutions do not meet universal design standards.

"In February and March 2022, the Office of the Public Defender monitored 59 free canteens operating in 25 municipalities of Georgia, based on the principle of random selection.

The free meals program is implemented in almost all municipalities, which is an important service for realizing the right to proper food. The right to adequate food means access to the food necessary for a healthy and active life, including a minimum ratio of adequate calories, protein, and other specific nutri-

According to the Public Defender's assessment, the current situation in some municipalities both in terms of food delivery service and sanitary-hygiene meets the minimum requirements, however, the overall picture is unsatisfactory.

The Public Defender points out that the Government of Georgia should ensure the development and approval of the basic standards of free canteen services, which will take into account the management of the

service, the calorie content of the menu, the quality of food, safety, sanitary-hygienic requirements, the improvement and equipment of food blocks, the observance of hygienic norms and other relevant issues.

- introduce a visa regime for citizens of the Russian Federation and Belarus (citizens of countries involved in hostilities with Ukraine);
- Determine the validity of tourist visas for up to 30 days (visas are issued directly at the border and/or online);
- For those who wish to stay more than 30 days, visas are issued according to the procedures drawn up according to the best practices of the European Union.
