The Monks' Wine

Making wine in Qvevri is the ancient Georgian tradition. The Monks' Wine made in Qvevri helps to cure one's body and soul. It offers a proper chance to express gratitude to the Lord, feast and get a pleasure. When you taste the Monks' Wine of Alaverdi you immediately feel the Georgian Royal Majesty and the grace of monastic simplicity.

The Royal Wine Cellar of the Monastery

Since the 11th century the Royal Monastery of Alaverdi represents a sacred place for the Kings of Kakheti-Mereti area, as well as the dwelling and laboring place of saints and monks. At the same time the Monastery and more precisely its wine cellar has become one of the core places of Qvevri type Kakhetian traditional winemaking. Today in the Alaverdi wine cellar the 21st century is grown old and the 11th century is rejuvenated, in order to let the old and modern technologies blend into one.
